The Officer plays an integral role in processing and administering road use permits, as well as enforcement activities associated with Road Use By-laws and the Weed Control Act. The enforcement includes field investigation, legal/prosecution activities, educating offenders, negotiating compliance, mediating disputes, issuing orders, laying charges, preparing for prosecution, record keeping, as well as attending court.

This position collaborates with area municipalities and public utilities and other community agencies in order to support and build community compliance with provisions of Road Use By-laws. The Officer also liaises with Regional Road Managers, municipal inspectors, utility companies, contractors, etc. in resolving problems relating to permits, complaints and requests for service, in order to ensure provision of coordinated and efficient by-law enforcement services.
