Eligible and working towards full membership in the Professional Engineers of Ontario. Minimum of two (2) years transportation engineering experience, preferably in a municipal environment. **AND** Proficient in the application of computer software programs related to areas of municipal servicing, project engineering/planning, transportation engineering/planning or project coordination and administration in accordance with job responsibilities. Excellent interpersonal, organizational, analytical/interpretive, and oral and written communication skills. Ability to deal courteously and effectively with public, consultants, developers, builders and contractors, etc. Working knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and other relevant Provincial statutes and regulations, in accordance with job responsibilities. Valid Class "G" Ontario driver's license in good standing with a reliable vehicle when required, to utilize on City business.
