

TRAFFIC TECHNOLOGIST

TRANSIT AND TRAFFIC DEPARTMENT

As the Traffic Technologist you will be responsible for preparing technical reports to Committee and Council detailing traffic issues such as neighbourhood traffic and safety concerns, geometric designs and the installation/revision of traffic control devices. You will respond to and investigate traffic complaints, resident concerns, and sight obstructions, usually involving site visits and working with concerned/interested parties to find a resolution. You may be required to appear before Committee to answer questions or clarify issues in your reports. In addition, you will maintain the traffic count and collision system/database including co-ordination of collision report input and updates. Using Traffic Engineering Software (T.E.S.), you will be required to perform statistical analysis of traffic data and provide recommendations for traffic operational improvements. You will also be required to attend Public Open Houses and administer various traffic related permits.

You will have three years related experience in addition to a Community College Diploma in Transportation Engineering. You will have the ability to communicate effectively both through the writing of technical reports and also verbally when dealing with City Council members, the public and senior staff. You have excellent teamwork and time management skills. You are proficient in Microsoft Office and possess experience in AutoCad and ArcView G.I.S. applications. Membership in OACETT as a Certified Engineering Technologist, experience with traffic related permits, road safety audits and T.E.S. are desirable assets.
