

ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR, TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND SYSTEMS

Under the direction of the Supervisor of Traffic Signals & Systems you will be responsible for field inspections of traffic signals and street lighting on Regional Roads. Responsibilities include; assisting with traffic signal and street light layouts; reviewing and approving construction methods and equipment proposed by the contractor; recording quantity and material measurements for payment; through daily/weekly field visits meet with electrical contractors to review ongoing work and resolve any operational problems; modify as-built drawings for signal installations; maintain and co-ordinate field records for inventory; provide direction to contractors, consultants and other Regional departments with respect to electrical installations; perform traffic signal timing changes as required; troubleshoot with our maintenance contractor communication and electrical problems and perform related duties as assigned.
